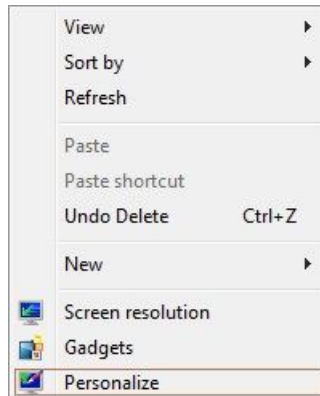


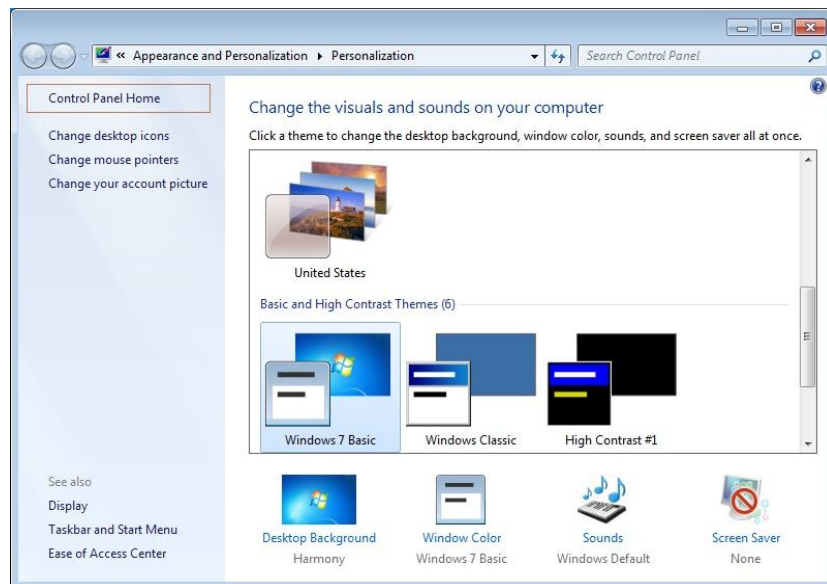
Windows 7 Install

A. Disable UAC feature on Windows 7

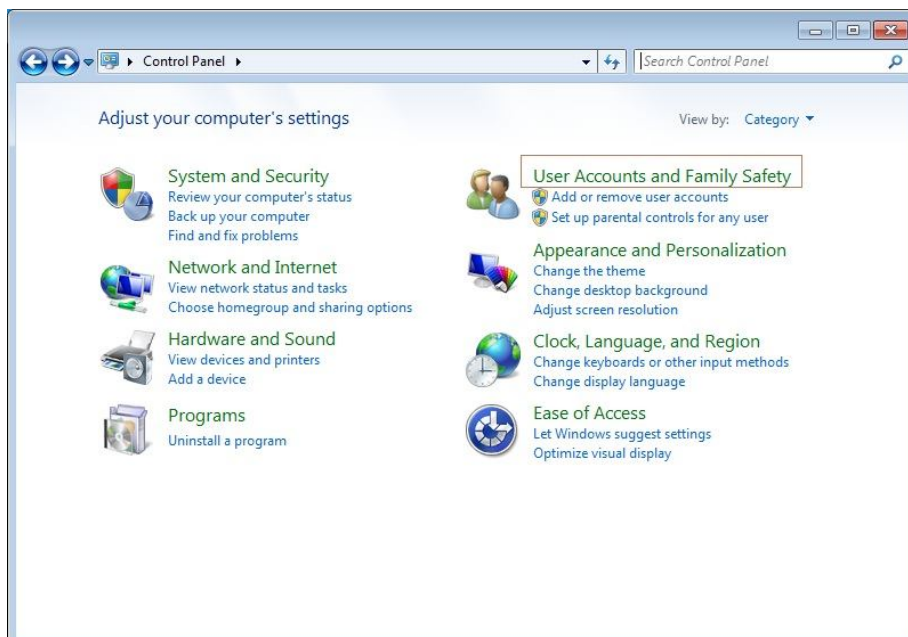
1. Right click any empty place on the Windows desktop and select **Personalize**.



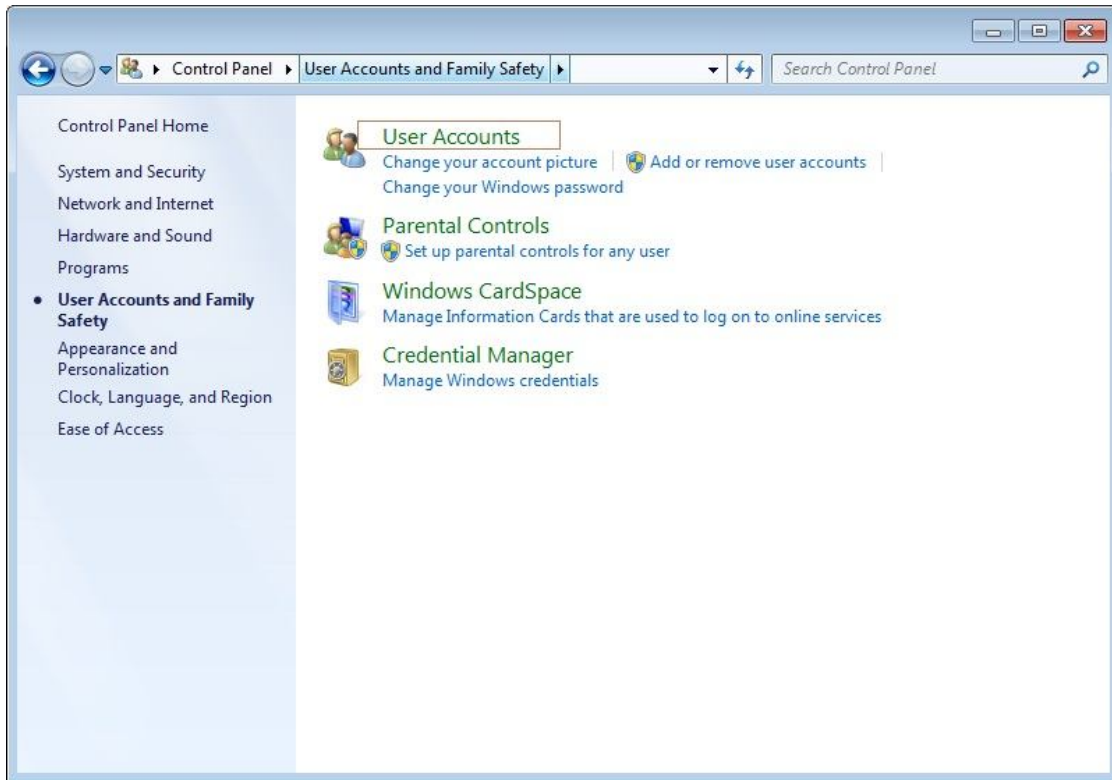
2. From the menu to the left, select **Control Panel Home**.



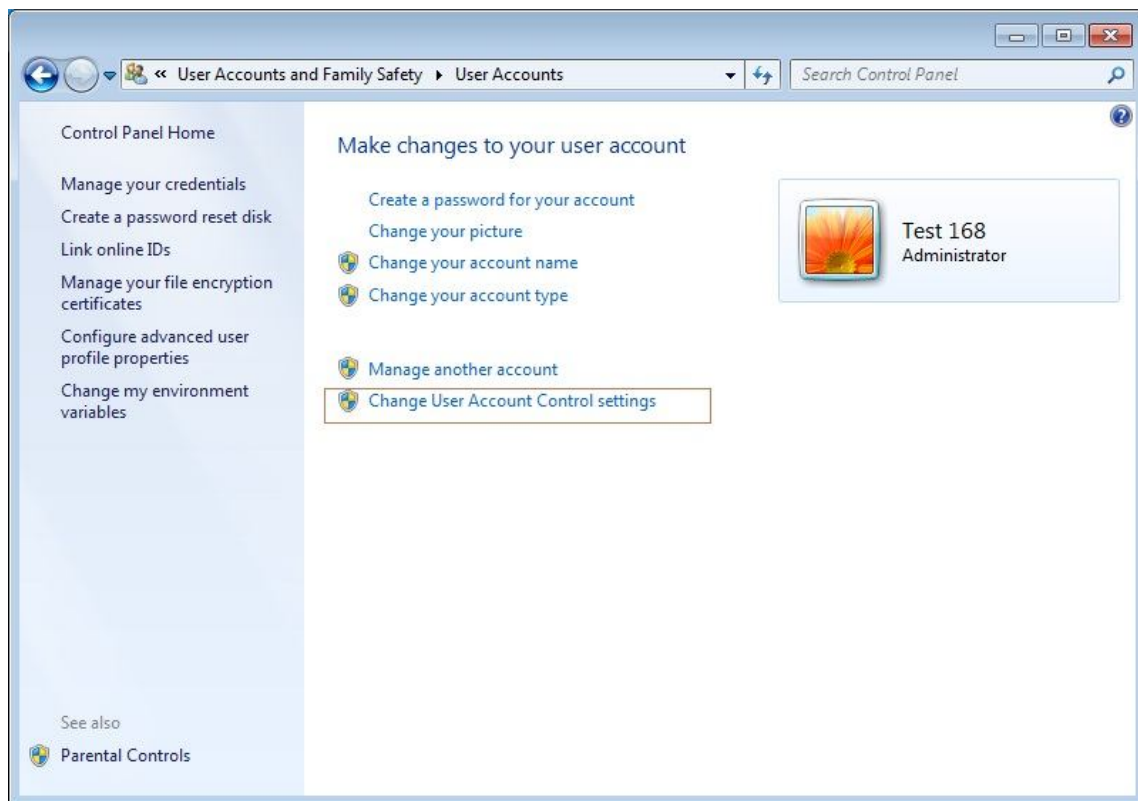
3. Select **User Accounts and Family Safety**.



4. Select **User Accounts**.

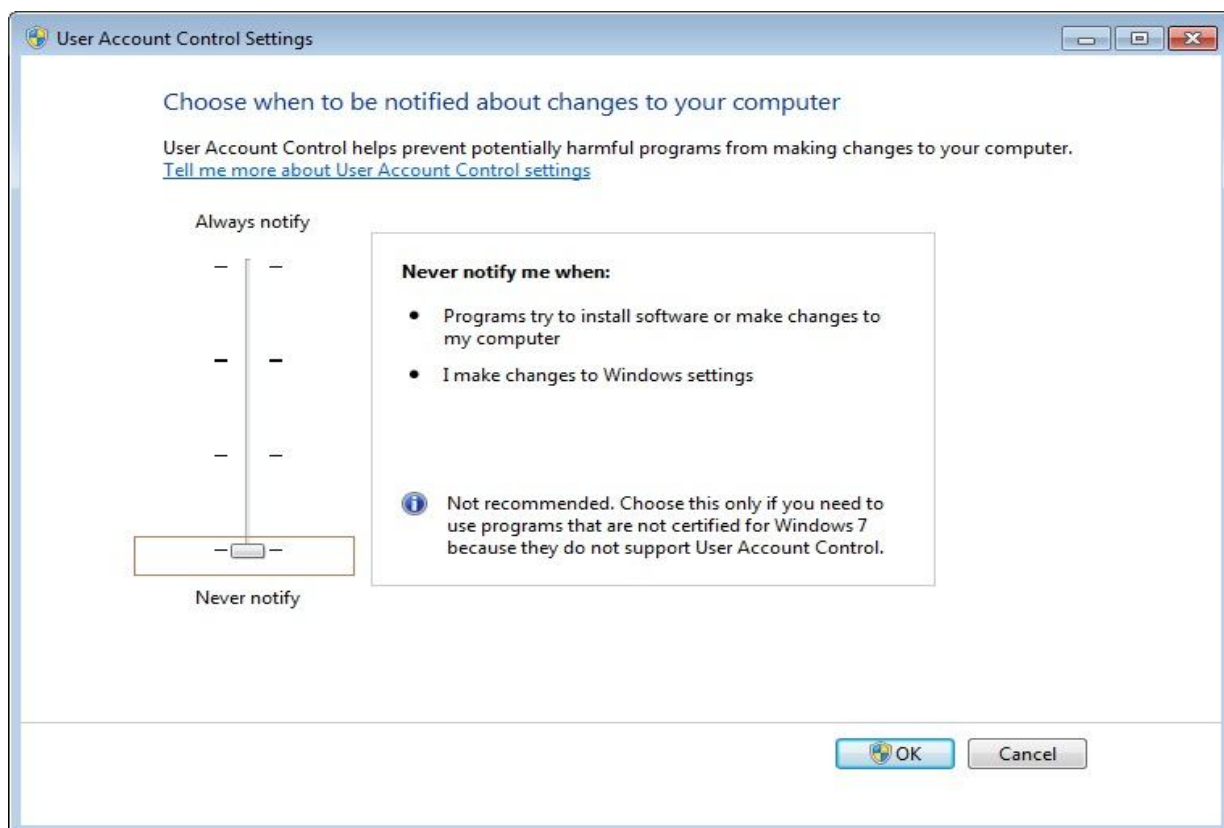
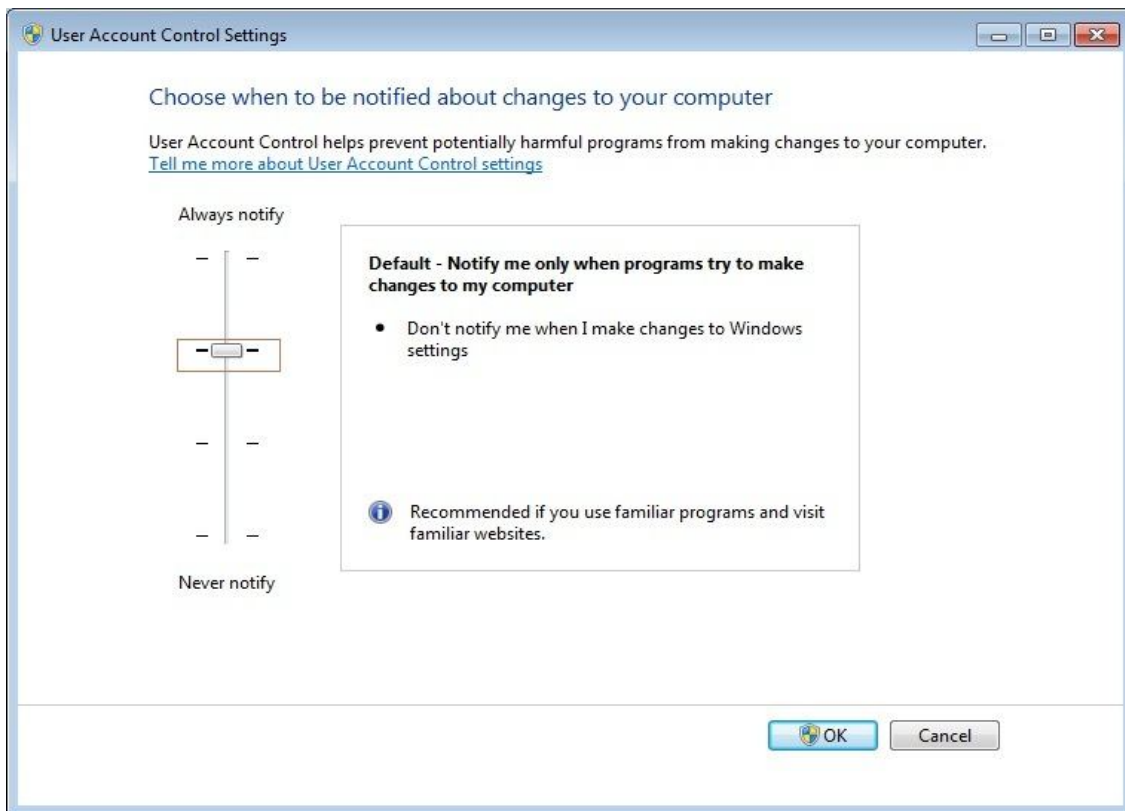


5. Select **Change User Account Control Settings**



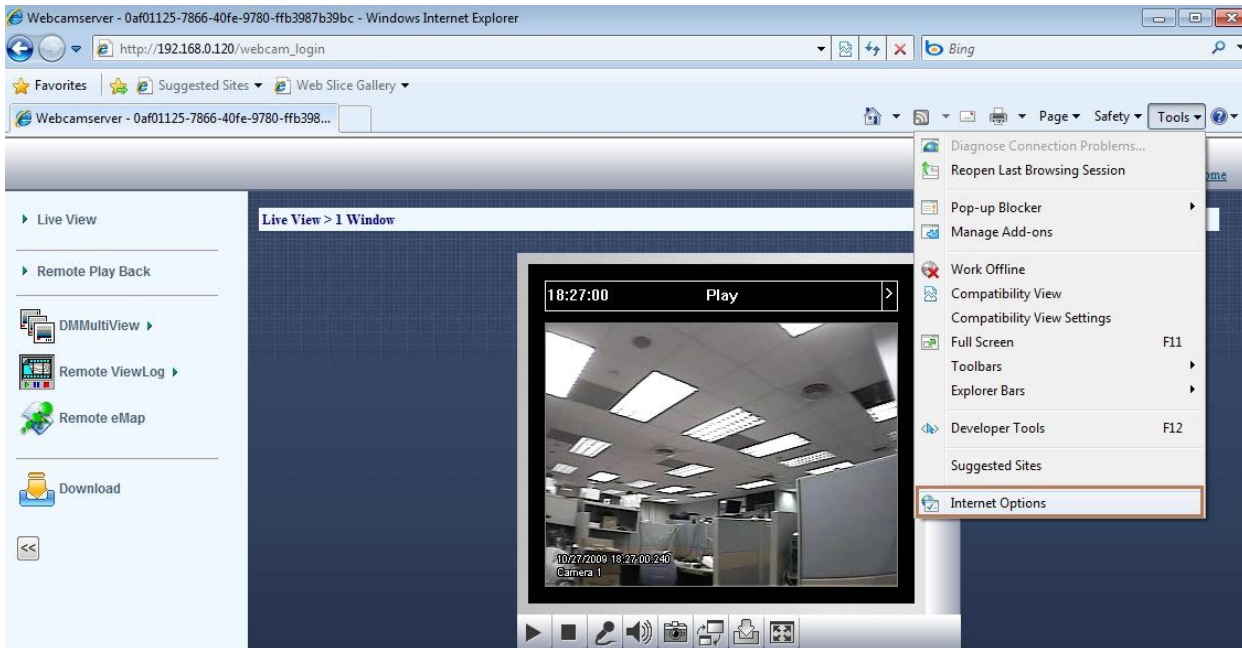
6. Lower the UAC level from **Default** to **Never notify**, and click on OK.

Next, restart your PC to apply the setting.

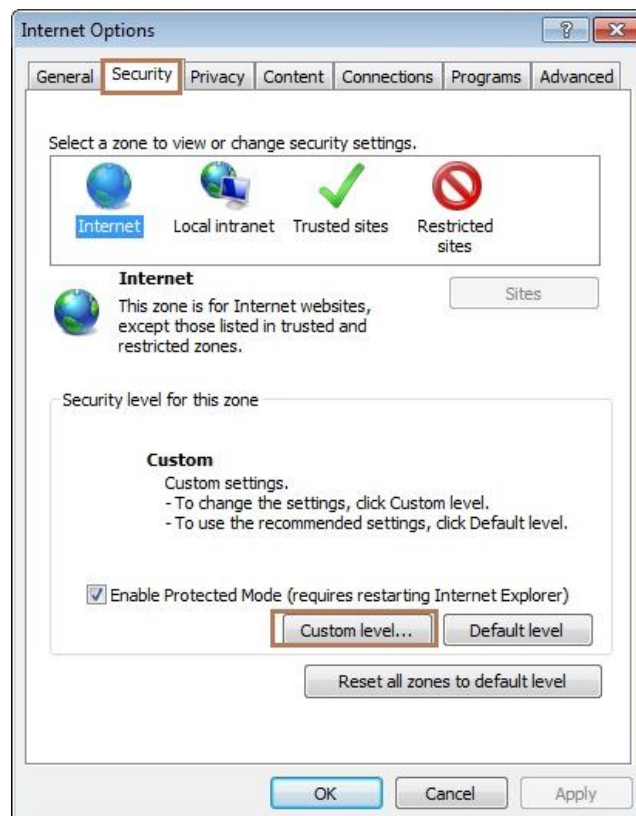


B. Adjust and lower Active X security level

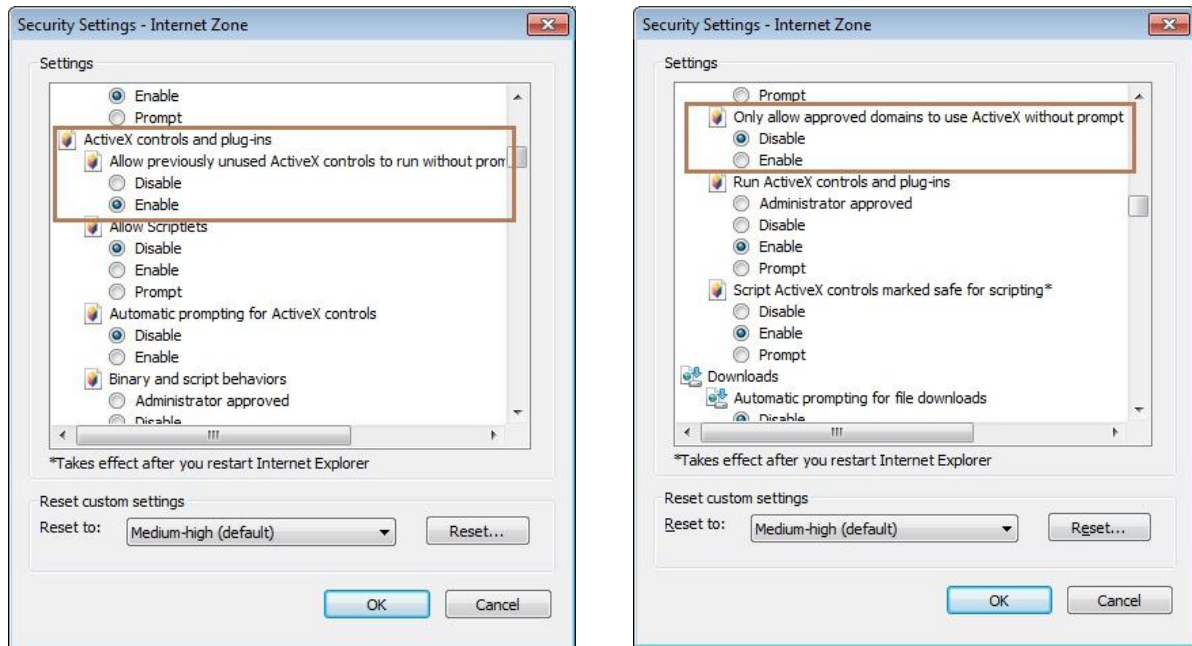
1. Open an Internet Explorer Window and, click on **Tools -> Internet Options**.



2. Under **Security tab**, Select **Internet zone**, and click on **Custom level**.



3. Enable "Allow previously unused Active controls to run without prompt" and disable "Only allow approved domains to use Active without prompt" within the setting window.



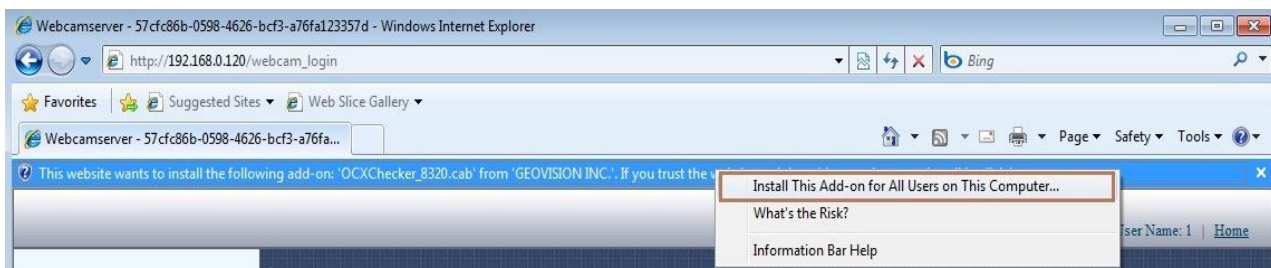
4. Click **OK** to save and close the Security settings window.

5. Click **OK** to save and exit from Internet Options window.

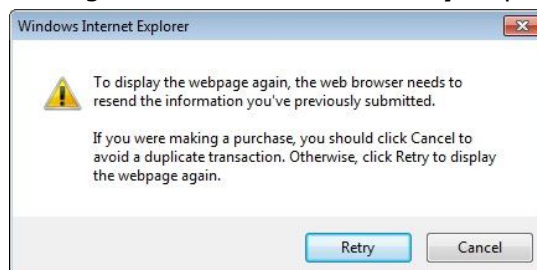
6. Close all Internet Explorer Windows.

7. Reconnect to the webcam server.

8. When prompted with the yellow bar shown in the screenshot below, select "Install This Add-on for All Users on This Computer".



9. You will be prompted with a message window. Click on **Retry** to proceed.



10. The page will refresh automatically, a prompt window will ask you if you wish to install the Webcam OCX. Click on Install to proceed.
